I would like to thank Inspector Rob Bryan for all his hard work and wish him well in his new post as Chief Inspector of Partnership. My vision is to build upon his achievements. I want to focus on crime prevention, reduce anti-social behaviour that affects the quality of life for residents, ensure that victims of crime receive the best service my staff can deliver and bring offenders to account. The local police will continue to work with residents, businesses and partnership agencies. In Hillingdon the Safer Neighbourhoods Teams are split into three sectors – North (headed by myself), East (Insp. Andrew Lewis) and West (Insp. Marlise Davies). - Ensure that mobile 'phones and purses are not left on tables or hanging out of pockets/handbags.
- Remember to be vigilant at cashpoints and put your money away securely before leaving. Be aware of people standing close by.
- When leaving the car, put your purchases in the boot, close windows and lock doors. Remove satnav and markings.
- **At home** do not leave your new purchases on show in the house or stow them in sheds or garages where locks may be inadequate.
- **After Christmas** dispose of boxes for high value items with care.
